Jolly Friends will have a potluck lunch in the FLC, Thursday, March 7th at 11:00am. Sign-up sheet in in the west hallway.

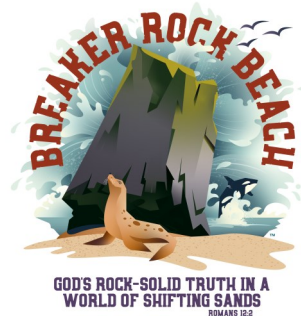
Open Discussion Meetings will be cancelled until further notice due to scheduling conflicts.
